Notice is given in accordance with the above Regulations that, on Tuesday 30 April 2019, Sevenoaks District Council submitted the Council's Local Plan to the Secretary of State for independent examination under Regulation 22 of the Town and County Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, along with the supporting documents.

Subject matter and Geographical Area

The Local Plan presents the spatial strategy, the policies and proposals to deliver homes (both market and affordable), employment and infrastructure to 2035. The Plan puts in place greater protections for our landscape and natural and historic environment and is heavily infrastructure-led, seeking to deliver new primary and secondary school provision, health facilities, transport improvements and open spaces. The policies of the Local Plan cover the full administrative area of the District.
