<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Under current legislation, all town and parish councils are entitled to a proportion of CIL contributions where qualifying development has occurred in the parish area and, parish and town councils are entitled to receive 15% of CIL contributions. However, the <u>Council's Cabinet in November 2014 (Minute 50)</u> agreed that all parish and town councils within the District will receive 25% of CIL contributions collected, regardless of charging area and whether a neighbourhood plan is in place. This would be calculated against the top CIL charging rate (£125 per sq. m.), resulting in discretionary "top-up" payments made by the District Council.
