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# **Limitation Statement**

The sole purpose of this technical report is to describe the processes by which the 2040 Sevenoaks Forecast Baseline have been carried out using the Kent Transport Model. This report should be read in full with no excerpts out of context deemed to be representative of the report and its findings as a whole. This report has been prepared exclusively for Jacobs and Jacobs' end client (Kent County Council) and no liability is accepted for any use or reliance on the report by third parties.

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# 1. Introduction

# 1.1 Background

Sevenoaks District Council (SDC) and Kent County Council (KCC) requested that Jacobs undertake an initial baseline transport assessment. This initial stage is intended to support the Regulation 18 Local Plan. It aims to understand the baseline data and identify potential transport challenges and opportunities that could help inform future decision making. In addition, this high-level assessment is being used to determine where additional data collection is required to support the detailed transport modelling work needed in the future. A separate gap analysis note was prepared to highlight these areas.

Lastly, this stage will also be used to inform discussions with National Highways on transport modelling assumptions and the approach, seeking their inputs and agreement in principle to the proposed methodology in preparation for the detailed transport modelling (i.e. for the Regulation 19 Plan). A meeting with National Highways and KCC has been scheduled for August 2022.

# 1.2 Purpose

This Report presents the analysis done on the existing base model and a review of available relevant data. It also describes the principles, assumptions and methodology employed to develop the initial 2040 baseline transport modelling work for Sevenoaks.

The scope of work includes the following:

- Task 1: Review of Available Data the 2019 Kent Transport Model, in its existing format as a countywide model, was used to inform the initial Regulation 18 Local Plan. This first task included the review of the existing base model and available data to identify potential issues and opportunities.
- Task 2: Initial Baseline "Soft-testing" this task involved high level trip generation and distribution tasks to develop the initial 2040 Forecast Baseline using the existing Kent Transport Model with committed developments in Sevenoaks. It should be noted that the residential and commercial developments included in this assessment were based on the list updated on 31 March 2021, which represents the most complete data available at the time of the modelling. In addition, no infrastructure schemes have been included in Sevenoaks in this initial stage. The list of the developments and infrastructure schemes will be reviewed again during the next detailed stage.
- Task 3: Gap Analysis to understand whether additional count data is required to support the detailed Local Plan specific transport modelling work required in the future. This additional data can be collected in September/October 2022 or later (to wait until the earliest possible neutral month to collect traffic count data) in preparation for detailed modelling work.

# 2. Existing Condition

#### 2.1 Overview

Sevenoaks district is located in the Southeast region of the country and is one of twelve district councils within Kent County. It is surrounded by eight neighbouring authorities such as Dartford (north), Gravesham (to the north-east), Bromley and Bexley in Greater London, Tandrige in Surrey (west), Wealden in East Sussex (south), Tunbridge Wells (south-east), and Tonbridge and Malling (east). The figure below shows the location of the district.

This section summarises the district's existing transport networks, including highways, public transport, walking and cycling routes. Based on the information provided by KCC and SDC, and documents available online, current transport challenges are also summarised in this section of the report.

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# 2.2 Existing Transport Network

#### 2.2.1 Highways – Major Corridors




Figure 2-2: Sevenoaks Major Corridors - Highways

Sevenoaks is surrounded by several key highway corridors which connect the area to its neighbouring districts and areas outside of Kent. The location and details of these corridors are presented in Figure 2-2 and the list below.

- M25 this orbital corridor provides both east-west and north-south connections and run past Swanley, Sevenoaks and Westerham. It provides connection between M20 at Swanley and A21 to the west of Sevenoaks. It is also connected to M26, however, there are no eastern slip roads from M25 to allow access to/from M26 east.
- M20 this corridor provides an east-west connection and is located to the north of Sevenoaks district and east of Swanley. It has direct connection to M25 (via M25 J3) and M26 (Wrotham Heath).
- M26 Similar to M20, this corridor provides an east-west connection providing direct link between M25 and M20.
- A25 this corridor runs parallel to M25 and M26 providing connections between the local roads and towns in Sevenoaks district.
- A20 this corridor provides an east-west connection between Wrotham, West Kingsdown, Farningham and Swanley.
- A21 this corridor provides a link between the M25 and A25 to the west of Sevenoaks Town to Tonbridge, Tunbridge Wells and East Sussex.



#### 2.2.2 Bus Services




Figure 2-3: Sevenoaks Bus Services

Figure 2-3 shows the bus services in Sevenoaks district and their connections to neighbouring authorities, and Table 2-1 provides details of the frequency of bus services on the available timetables provided by Arriva. Of the six bus services listed below, routes 306/308, 402/402a/402b/402w and 489 provide the highest frequency. These services are suitable for commuter trips to employment areas located outside the district. Route 306/308 provides a connection to Gravesend, route 402/402a/402b/402w to Tonbridge and Tunbridge Wells and route 489 to Gravesend Town Centre from New Ash Green.

In addition, Go Coach also operates in the Sevenoaks district, providing connections between the rural areas and the towns. Most of these services only run during school days and have limited frequency during peak hours. The table below summarises the bus services offered by Go Coach.

#### 2.2.3 Rail




Figure 2-4: Sevenoaks Train Services

Southeastern, Thameslink and Southern operate the train services that call at stations located in Sevenoaks. Figure 2-4 detail the rail network map in Sevenoaks.

Southeastern trains call at Sevenoaks, Dunton Green. Knockholt, Swanley, Farningham Road and Longfield stations. They provide access to central London, Hastings, Ashford, Maidstone, Canterbury and Sandwich. Thameslink allows access to central London and Welwyn Garden City from Sevenoaks station. Southern train calls at Edenbridge, Penshurst, Leigh, Edenbridge Town Centre, Hever and Cowden. It provides access to Redhill, Tonbridge, London Bridge and Uckfield.

In addition, Darenth Valley Line connects the towns of Swanley and Sevenoaks and calls at Swanley, Eynsford, Shoreham, Otford, Bat and Ball and Sevenoaks.

#### 2.2.4 Walking and Cycling




Figure 2-5: Walking Routes in Sevenoaks – Swanley




Figure 2-7: Walking Routes in Sevenoaks – Edenbridge

Figure 2-5 to Figure 2-7 illustrate the available Public Right of Way (PRoW) routes across the district, as taken from the online KCC PRoW map. Overall, there is an extensive network of walking routes across the urban area, and are primarily made up of footpaths, promoted routes and byways (BOAT). Outside the towns of Swanley, Sevenoaks and Edenbridge, bridleways can also be found in some sections of the network.

The routes provide reasonable connectivity for undertaking short trips between destinations, or as part of a longer journey when travelling in and around the urban area of the district on foot; though some of these routes are not convenient at all times of the day, particularly at night and in the winter.

In terms of cycling, according to the Propensity to Cycle Tool ((<a href="https://www.pct.bike">https://www.pct.bike</a>), the percentage of cycling use in Sevenoaks is around 1%. This is based on the 2011 Census and is slightly lower than some areas in Kent (particularly in east Kent) with 2% up to 9%.




Figure 2-8: Percentage of Cycling to Work – Sevenoaks

According to Sevenoaks Cycling Strategy, there is a small number of existing cycle routes in the district, which leads to the small percentage of users switching to this mode. The existing cycle connections and linkages are the following:

- National Cycle Route 12 (NCR 12) which connects Penshurst Place with Tonbridge
- On carriageway advisory route, A20, West Kingsdown
- On carriageway advisory route, Old London Road, Halstead
- Segregated Shared use cycleway, London Road, Swanley
- Segregated Shared use cycleway between Cranleigh Drive and Goldsel Road, Swanley
- Short section of Segregated shared use cycleway which runs from the traffic lights junction at Stangrove Road/Mont St Aignan Way to the High Street, Edenbridge
- Short section of cut through cycle lane from Station Road to Minstrels Close, Edenbridge



# 2.3 Active Travel Strategy

Sevenoaks District Council in partnership with Kent County Council and Sevenoaks Cycling Forum have prepared a Sevenoaks District Cycling Strategy which aims to encourage more people to cycle and shift towards more sustainable choices. In line with this, the following priority areas have been identified:

- Creating new routes and linkages
- Safer cycling
- Improvements to cycle parking
- Promotion and Encouragement
- Maintenance

More information can be found on the Sevenoaks District Cycling Strategy Report including the proposed cycle routes in Sevenoaks Town Centre, Swanley and Edenbridge.

In addition, the Local Cycling and Walking Improvement Plan (LCWIP) for Sevenoaks is currently in progress and follows the six stages outlined in the Department for Transport's LCWIP Technical Guidance. As part of Stage 2 (Gathering Information), existing transport infrastructures have been reviewed together with a review and mapping of existing trip generators/attractors and proposed developments. The Propensity to Cycle Tool was also analysed for the existing and future cycling patterns. At the moment, Sevenoaks is working on Stage 3 (Network Planning for Cycling) and Stage 4 (Network Planning for Walking). Draft cycle and walking network maps have been prepared based on the information gathered in Stage 2 and feedback from the public consultation held in May 2022.

Lastly, the district's Movement Strategy (April 2022) aims to enable the movement across the district to be easy, healthy, safe, low carbon and sustainable. The strategy also highlighted the following key priorities and initiatives:

- Health and Wellbeing
  - Improve air quality by reducing vehicle emissions
  - Promote active travel and making it easier for people of all ages and abilities to move around by foot
  - Increasing the number of "safe" routes
  - Encourage positive behaviour change for healthier choices
  - Support and provide opportunities for social prescribing
  - Promote access for all
- Cycling and Walking
  - Increase the number and improve the safety of cycling routes
  - Work with partners to improve the walking routes into and through the district
  - Make walking and cycling easier through improved connections and improved infrastructure
  - Encourage behaviour change through community engagement, training and awareness
- Public Transport
  - Improve the quality, legibility and accessibility of public transport and remove barriers
  - Strengthen connections between transport modes to improve access and to support "first and last mile" connections
  - Improve the public transport environment and experience to ensure safety, with better wayfinding and signage
  - Proactively engaging with public transport providers
- Sustainable Movement
  - Improve electric vehicle use and infrastructure within the district
  - Support suitable innovative low emission alternatives for short and long-distance travel
  - Support local services and facilities and sustainable neighbourhoods
  - Reduce the need for private car ownership and support suitable low car neighbourhoods
  - To develop a robust and sustainable Sevenoaks District Council travel plan



# 2.4 Existing Transport Network Challenges

Using the information above, high level analysis has identified some of the key challenges with respect to traffic congestion, public transport, walking and cycling, which are summarised below.

In the next section, the existing transport model is used to identify "hot spot" areas where traffic congestion is experienced, which can also affect public transport and propensity to use active modes as well as worsen the environment and liveability. It should be noted that for this initial stage, no assessment has been completed to review the impacts on the environment and public transport. However, this can be considered in the next detailed stage of the study.

#### 2.4.1 Highways

Sevenoaks district has very high levels of car ownership and usage. The 2011 Census shows that 87% of households in the district have at least one car, compared to 80% across Kent and 74% in England.

A small number of main roads are heavily relied upon, and this is most evident on the congested roads converging to the town centres of Swanley, Sevenoaks and Edenbridge. During peak periods, part of the road network operates at or near capacity. This congestion has been caused by current road traffic volumes outgrowing its capacity as a consequence of the reliance placed on the private car, alongside population and job growth in the wider area.

#### 2.4.2 Public Transport

Sevenoaks district has 17 train stations which provide good connections to its neighbouring districts and central London. According to the 2011 Census, 19.3% of its commuters used trains which is significantly higher when compared to 8.9% across Kent and 5.1% in England.

For the district's bus networks, services with highest frequency are focused mainly on serving Sevenoaks Town and areas around Swanley and New Ash Green. Go Coach provides the connection between the rural areas and towns; however, the frequency of the services is limited, especially during the peak hour. Hence, the outer suburban and rural communities do not have access to convenient and frequent bus services. While trains offer direct services to London and other towns in Kent, the stations along these routes have relatively limited connectivity with bus services making interchanging between rail and bus inconvenient.

#### 2.4.3 Walking and Cycling

The 2011 Census travel to work data found that, despite 6.5% of journeys to work being undertaken by foot, only 1% of journeys to work were undertaken by bike. This low percentage is due to the district's limited cycling routes and facilities, as highlighted in the existing cycle strategy. Several roads are also subject to high volumes of traffic which cause problems for those wishing to travel into the town centres or to other towns via active modes. In addition, the district's topography is generally elevated, making some routes challenging to walk and cycle. At the moment, Sevenoaks District Council are preparing a Local Cycling and Walking Improvement Plan where draft cycle and walking network maps have been prepared.



# 3. 2019 Base Transport Model

#### 3.1 Overview

The 2019 Kent Transport Model, in its existing format as a countywide model was used to identify key junction and link issues. Junction level of service and link volume / capacity ratio indicators were extracted from the model to support the analysis for the AM (08:00 - 09:00) and PM (17:00 - 18:00) peak periods. Observed journey time data was also analysed to help inform the existing delays in the study area.

# 3.2 Model Outputs Criteria

Junction Level of Service (LOS) and link Volume / Capacity (VOC) ratio indicators were used as criteria to identify the link and junction "hot spots" in the study area.

Level of service plots provide a qualitative measure of the junction performance. As actual flow will vary for different days and different times in a day, LOS relates the traffic service quality to a given flow rate of traffic. VISUM defines the LOS based on the mean delay experienced by each vehicle. VISUM has the capability to calculate LOS for all types of junctions (priority, roundabout and signalised junctions). Table 3-1 defines the LOS by six levels ranging from level A to level F.

А	Level A represents the best quality of traffic where the driver has the freedom to drive with free flow speed.
В	Level B represents good traffic quality where driver can reasonably maintain free flow speed and maneuverability within the traffic stream is slightly restricted.
С	Level C represents stable traffic flows, at or near free flow. Ability to manoeuvre through lanes is noticeably restricted and requires awareness.
D	Level D represents almost unstable traffic flows. Speeds slightly decrease as traffic volume slightly increase. On this level driver comfort decreases.
E	Level E represents unstable traffic flows, operating at capacity. Driver's level of comfort becomes poor.
F	Level F represents the worst traffic quality with forced or breakdown traffic flows. Travel time cannot be predicted, with generally more demand than capacity.

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On the other hand, volume / capacity is the ratio of assigned traffic volume to the modelled link capacity and the ranges used are set out below.

V/C Ratio	Description
<= 75%	Stable flow with acceptable delay
<= 85%	Approaching unstable flow but with tolerable delay
<= 100%	Unstable flow at capacity
> 100%	Over-capacity

# 3.3 2019 Junction and Link "Hot-Spots"




Figure 3-1: 2019 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks District

Figure 3-1 to Figure 3-8 show the junction LOS and link V/C ratio for 2019 AM and PM peak periods. In the AM, the majority of the junctions and links in Sevenoaks district display little to moderate levels of delay (LOS B to D and V/C < 85%). However, some of the key junctions and links in the district exhibit severe levels of delay (LOS E and F and V/C > 85%). These include M25 J3, B258 and B2173 High Street and B2173 London Road in Swanley, Pembroke Road/A225 High Street/Suffolk Way in Sevenoaks Town, A25 Seal Road and A25 High Street in Sevenoaks Town and B2026 / Stangrove Road and B2026 / Station Road in Edenbridge Town Centre. Similar patterns are found in the PM peak, with Main Road/Dartford Road exhibiting LOS E.

Teletrac journey time data was also analysed to identify the existing delays in the study area, and these are presented in Figure 3-9 and Figure 3-10. The result of the analysis confirms the locations highlighted above where delays are observed along the roads around Swanley (and especially M25 junction 3), Sevenoaks Town and Edenbridge Town Centre.




Figure 3-2: 2019 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Swanley






Figure 3-3: 2019 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks Town




Figure 3-5: 2019 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks District






Figure 3-6: 2019 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Swanley






Figure 3-7: 2019 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks Town




Figure 3-9: 2019 AM Peak Percentage of Free Flow Speed – Teletrac Data






Figure 3-10: 2019 PM Peak Percentage of Free Flow Speed – Teletrac Data



# 4. Initial 2040 Forecast Baseline

#### 4.1 Overview

This section summarises the methodology and assumptions used to develop the initial forecast baseline for Sevenoaks. A forecast of 2040 has been modelled with the use of combined TEMPro v7.2 growth assumptions in the neighbouring districts and currently committed developments in Sevenoaks district.

A set of output plots have been produced to show the flow difference, junction level of service and link volume capacity ratio in order to help identify key "hot spot" areas.

# 4.2 Forecast Network Development

Following consultation with SDC and KCC, no committed infrastructure schemes were identified at this initial stage of the study. A number of infrastructure schemes in Sevenoaks district are currently within the consent process or at the pre-application stage; however, there is still uncertainty in terms of their status. Hence, for the initial forecast baseline, the road network is assumed to be similar to the 2019 Base. This will be reviewed again in the next detailed stage.

#### 4.3 Forecast Demand Development

For Sevenoaks district, developments classified as "near certain" and "more than likely" were included in the 2040 transport model, and no TEMPro growth was applied. This assumes a hypothetical situation of no further growth in the district to establish the baseline scenario. In the areas outside the study area, direct TEMPro v7.2 growth were applied to take into account broader general background growth.

Kent Transport Model trip rates derived from Trip Rate Information Computer System (TRICS) were used for each committed development to generate vehicular trips. Base donor zones with similar land use in the vicinity of the new developments were used to get similar origin and destination information for each development to distribute vehicle trips around the network.

For the Stage 2 detailed transport modelling work, in addition to the base model calibration and validation, details regarding the TEMPro growth will be reviewed (i.e., taking into account the likely level of expected growth in the key neighbouring areas). Trip rates will also be refined and agreed case-by-case with National Highways, KCC and SDC.

Table 4-1 presents the total number of dwellings and employment areas assumed in the 2040 model, and Figure 4-1 shows the locations of these developments. Full details can be found in Appendix A. For employment, several sites have been proposed to be demolished and replaced by housing or other developments. These changes in the use were taken into consideration to avoid double counting. Hence, the table below presents a reduction in the employment sites.

It should be noted that the residential and commercial developments included in this assessment were based on the list updated on 31 March 2021, which represents the most complete data available at the time of the modelling. This list will be reviewed again during the next detailed stage.

#### 4.4 Goods Vehicle Growth Factors

General growth in LGV and HGV demand has been produced by constraining to growth factors derived from the Road Traffic Forecasts (RTF 2018) published by DfT. The RTF traffic mileage data for all road types was extracted from Scenario 1 for LGV and HGV and then interpolated to derive growth factors for 2040 from 2019. The resulting growth factors are shown in the table below and applied at an assignment (peak hour) matrix level.

#### 4.5 Forecast Results

#### 4.5.1 Flow Difference Plots




Figure 4-2 – 2040 vs 2019 Flow Difference - AM Peak






Figure 4-3 – 2040 vs 2019 Flow Difference - PM Peak

Flow difference plots have been produced to show the difference in actual flows between the initial 2040 Forecast Baseline and 2019 Base models. These are presented in Figure 4-2 and Figure 4-3.

Comparing the 2040 and 2019 models, significant increase in traffic is predicted along major corridors such as M25, M20, M26 and A21. These are then followed by small increases in traffic predicted along A224 London Road, Shoreham Road, A224 Orpington By-Pass, A225 Dartford Road and in local roads around the town centre in Swanley, Sevenoaks and Edenbridge.

#### 4.5.2 2040 Junction and Link "Hot Spots"




Figure 4-4: 2040 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks District

Figure 4-4 to Figure 4-11 show the junction LOS and link V/C ratio for 2040 AM and PM peak periods. A comparison to the 2019 Base model was also made to highlight the projected level of change in the LOS and V/C ratio. These are presented in Figure 4-12 and Figure 4-13.

The majority of the junction and link "hot spots" identified in the base model also exists in the 2040 models. These include junctions located in Swanley, Sevenoaks Town and Edenbridge Town Centre. In addition to these locations, M25 (between Westerham and J3), A20 Main Road (between A225 Eynsford and A225 Dartford Road), Pembroke Road / A225 London Road/Argyle Road, A25 (between A224 London Road and Shoreham Lane) and B2026/Lingfield Road are predicted to experience severe level of delays.

The percentage of free flow speed extracted from the 2040 model and presented in Figure 4-14 and Figure 4-15 also confirms delays could be expected at these locations.




Figure 4-5: 2040 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Swanley






Figure 4-6: 2040 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks Town






Figure 4-7: 2040 AM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Edenbridge Town Centre






Figure 4-8: 2040 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks District






Figure 4-9: 2040 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Swanley






Figure 4-10: 2040 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Sevenoaks Town






Figure 4-11: 2040 PM Peak Junction and Link "Hot Spots" – Edenbridge Town Centre






Figure 4-12: 2040 vs 2019 LOS and VC Comparison – AM Peak






Figure 4-13: 2040 vs 2019 LOS and VC Comparison – PM Peak






Figure 4-14: 2040 AM Peak Percentage of Free Flow Speed






Figure 4-15: 2040 PM Peak Percentage of Free Flow Speed



## 5. Summary

This Report describes the methods used to develop the Initial 2040 Forecast Baseline and approach taken to identify the key junction and link "hots spots" in Sevenoaks district.

Overall, the 2019 AM and PM outputs present similar locations of junction and link "hot spots". The majority of the junctions exhibiting LOS E and F, or links displaying unstable flows (>85%) or which are over capacity (>100%), are located along:

- M25 J3
- B258 and B2173 High Street and B2173 London Road in Swanley Town
- A20 Main Road / A225 Dartford Road in Farningham
- Pembroke Road / A225 High Street / Suffolk Way in Sevenoaks Town
- A25 Seal Road and A25 High Street in Sevenoaks Town
- B2026 / Stangrove Road in Edenbridge Town
- B2026/Station Road in Edenbridge Town

The Teletrac data analysis also confirms issues around these locations, highlighting the areas where delays are observed.

Committed developments were identified in collaboration with KCC and SDC and were implemented in the Initial 2040 Forecast Baseline. The 2040 model shows increases in traffic flows in major corridors, particularly around M25, M20, M26, and A21. Increases in traffic flows are also predicted along A224 London Road, Shoreham Road, A224 Orpington By-Pass, A225 Dartford Road and in local roads around the town centre in Swanley, Sevenoaks and Edenbridge.

In terms of junction and link "hot spots" in 2040, the majority of those locations identified in 2019 are still problematic in 2040. However, due to the overall growth assumed, additional areas, junctions and links were identified:

- M25 (between Westerham and J3)
- A20 Main Road (between A225 Eynsford and A225 Dartford Road)
- Pembroke Road / A224 London Road / Argyle Road in Sevenoaks Town
- A25 (between A224 London Road and Shoreham Lane) in Sevenoaks Town
- B2026/Lingfield Road in Edenbridge Town






Figure 5-1: Sevenoaks Initial 2040 Baseline Junction and Link "Hot Spots"

This initial forecast scenario has been developed in order to test the impacts of current committed developments within Sevenoaks and overall growth in neighbouring districts to Sevenoaks to start to understand the baseline traffic issues prior to Local Plan. This report covers initial high-level transport assessment to identify the baseline "hot spot" areas. Detailed transport modelling is recommended to assess these areas in detail and to assess potential Local Plan development prior to Regulation 19. In addition to option testing, further work can also be considered to assess environmental and public transport impacts.
