The unaudited statement of accounts for 2022/23 will also be available at <a href="https://www.Sevenoaks.gov.uk">www.Sevenoaks.gov.uk</a>.. The accounts may be subject to change pending the outcome of review by the appointed auditor.

During this period, a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, or their representative, may question the auditor about the accounts, or make an objection to the accounts as set out in sections 26 and 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Any objection, and the grounds on which it is made, must be sent to the auditor in writing, with a copy to the Deputy Chief Executive and Chief Officer - Finance and Trading at Council Offices, Argyle Road, Sevenoaks, Kent, TN13 1HG. Any objection must state the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.
