ROMANI WAY HOUSING APPLICATION

Sevenoaks District Council has one Gypsy and Traveller site situated at Romani Way, Hever Road, Edenbridge.

You must complete this form if you wish to be considered for a pitch at Romani Way.

There are also Gypsy and Traveller Sites managed by Kent County Council – applications for these Sites should be made through Kent County Council.

Our Role

Romani Way site is owned and managed by Sevenoaks District Council and provides accommodation for households who fall within the following definition:

Persons of nomadic habit of life, whatever their race or origin, including such persons who on grounds only of their own or their families or dependants educational or health needs or old age have ceased to travel temporarily or permanently, and all other persons with a cultural tradition of nomadism and/or caravan dwelling.

Who can apply for Hever Road Site waiting list?

The following people/households are eligible to make an application to be considered for inclusion on the Council's Gypsy and Traveller Register

- Are from a Gypsy and Traveller background (see definition above)
- Are aged 18 or over
- Are currently living in the Sevenoaks District and have been resident for a continuous period of three years at the point of application. This does not include households placed in temporary accommodation under homelessness legislation or the Children's Act 1989.
- Are currently employed in the District and your place of work is within the District and you have been working within the District continuously for the last three years at the point of application
- Are self-employed, where documentary evidence shows at least 50% of your work is within the District, and this has been the case continuously for the last three years at the point of application
- Are an applicant for whom we have accepted the main housing duty under homelessness legislation (s193 Housing Act 1996)

- Members of the Gypsy and Traveller community who are transitory will have their application assessed on priority need
- Are persons or households who apply as qualifying persons and meet the criteria because of exceptional circumstances or special needs, regardless of their previous address

Exemptions

The following exemptions to the above criteria may apply:

- Applicants who have previously lived in the District
- Applicants who have close family connections i.e. children, parents, grandparents or siblings only where those connections continue to exist.

Existing family groupings will be considered when allocation pitches to new occupiers to minimise potential conflict, both within the Romani Way site and with residents living nearby.

Restrictions

We currently run a waiting list for Romani Way as the number of applicants exceed the number of pitches that become available. Allocation of a pitch aims to achieve a balance between meeting accommodation needs and ensuring the quality of life for all existing residents is not detrimentally affected.

Exclusion from the Register

Certain people/households may be excluded from the register. The decision that a person/household is excluded may occur at the time of application or, if accepted on to the register, at any time during the life of the application.

Applicants may not be eligible for inclusion on the Gypsy and Traveller register if there is evidence of recent behaviour, by an applicant or a member of their household, likely to affect the management of Romani Way and/or adversely impact the Romani Way community.

The Sevenoaks District Gypsy and Traveller Allocation Policy will take account of any unacceptable behaviour of an applicant or member of their household. If there is current or historical evidence of unacceptable behaviour, then this will make an applicant unsuitable to be a licensee and their application will be withdrawn.

Examples of exclusions can be found at Point 6 of the Sevenoaks District Gypsy and Traveller Allocation Policy.



PRIORITY

Sevenoaks District Gypsy and Traveller Allocation Policy contains a number of priority bands which ensure that the Council meets its policy aims and commitments. This means that some applications have more priority than others.

Eligibility for a pitch at Romani Way is based on priority order according to housing and support needs. The banding system ranks the level or urgency of a need for a pitch, from Band A (most urgent need) to Band D (reduced priority).

Following verification and assessment, each applicant(s) will be placed in a band dependant upon housing need. Applicant(s) will be notified of priority banding.


